



Selection criteria for HCPSL Extension Agronomist (defined contract period):

Essential criteria

1. A tertiary qualification (preferably a Degree or Diploma) in agriculture, horticulture, NRM or a similar qualification.
2. At least 2-5 years' experience in sugarcane agriculture or associated agricultural industries (would be desirable), however new graduates would be considered if they have a genuine passion and desire to work within agriculture.
3. Current class C drivers' licence for manual vehicles.
4. Demonstrated experience in fostering good working relationships with a diverse range of organisations and individuals.
5. Facilitate extension processes; either one on one, group or mass media extension activities.
6. Demonstrated spoken and written communication skills.
7. Computer literate with demonstrated experience of word processing, spreadsheets, Power Point and some other applications.
8. Demonstrated knowledge of occupational health and safety requirements.
9. Must be legally entitled to work in Australia.

Desirable criteria

1. Demonstrated knowledge of sugarcane production, pests and diseases, agronomy, natural resource management, soil and water management (preferred but not essential).
2. Demonstrated experience in project management including budgeting, reporting, project monitoring and evaluation (preferred but not essential).
3. Experience with GISs (preferred but not essential).
4. Experience with analysing data and basic statistics training (preferred but not essential).
