What will growers need to do?

Participating growers are required to adopt on a small scale two farming practices changes.

Some examples could be:

- Growing a mixed legume crop
- Zero or Minimum cultivation into a legume crop
- Using Enhanced Efficiency Fertilisers
- Adopting banded mud application at less than 75T/ha
- Zonal or Variable rate amendments & or micro-nutrients.
