

SELECTION CRITERIA

Position: Junior Field Technician

Essential criteria:

- 1. Must have a genuine desire to work in the sugarcane industry.
- 2. Must be physically fit and have the ability to undertake manual tasks, including lifting and carrying heavy objects, and work outdoors.
- 3. A C class drivers licence, or the ability and willingness to attain a C class licence within 12 months of employment.
- 4. Sound spoken and written communication skills.
- 5. Computer literate with some experience, or demonstrated ability to learn, word processing and spreadsheets.
- 6. An understanding of the importance of occupational health and safety (OHS) and the importance of working in a safe and inclusive work environment.
- 7. Must be an Australian citizen.

Desirable criteria (preferred but not essential):

- 1. Demonstrated knowledge of sugarcane production (crop management, planting and harvesting operations, pest and diseases identification and management etc).
- 2. Experience with agricultural technology GPS, GIS, and precision agriculture technologies (preferred but not essential).
