

# Field trip and workshop: Managing the wetter parts of my farm



## Join us for a field trip to Tully and hands-on workshop

Herbert Cane Productivity Services (HCPSSL) and the Department of Primary Industries (DPI) invite you to a field trip and workshop on managing wetter parts of your farm beside your cane blocks. This includes low spots, areas where water flows and natural areas like wetlands and creek banks. We will discuss ways to manage these areas to sustain production, reduce long-term maintenance while also improving local water quality and habitat.

### Outline of the day:

8:00 – 13:00 Field trip to Tully to hear about the role of vegetation in drainage lines, how to manage creek banks and wetlands, and learn how to take a water sample for analysis.

13:00 – 16:00 Hands-on workshop with farm mapping to identify drainage lines, flow pathways, water-related challenges and natural systems. Then plan management actions in those 'wetter parts of the farm'.
