HOW TO ENTER

Pigs must be trapped within the Hinchinbrook Shire and humanely euthanised in accordance with Australian Standards and the National Code of Practice for the Humane Control of Feral Pigs. Photo evidence and GPS location required for each capture. Property owner permission required where applicable.
